

- 1. Protect life
- 2. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
- 3. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
- 4. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
- 5. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

## WEATHER

- Tropical Storm winds likely to reach South-Central LA coast by mid-morning Wednesday (9/11)
- Francine is forecasted to strengthen into a Category 1 Hurricane this evening (9/10) or overnight (9/11)
- · Forward speed is expected to increase before landfall
- Last 24 hours have shown a slight nudge East in storm track
