INCIDENT OBJECTIVES

1. Protect life
2. Ensure the safety of the first responders during event
3. Clear and maintain roadways to facilitate safe transportation and provide timely information to drivers about road conditions and potential hazards
4. Secure and protect vulnerable infrastructure such as public water systems and hospitals
5. Ensure the availability and efficient use of resources

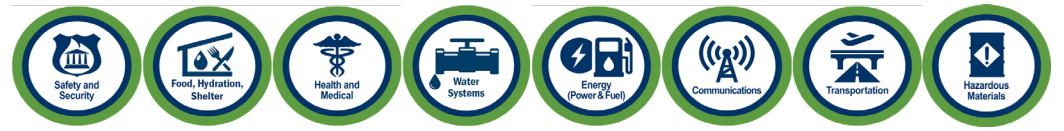
WEATHER

- Tropical Storm winds likely to reach South-Central LA coast by mid-morning Wednesday (9/11)
- Francine is forecasted to strengthen into a Category 1 Hurricane this evening (9/10) or overnight (9/11)
- Forward speed is expected to increase before landfall
- Last 24 hours have shown a slight nudge East in storm track

Safety and Security

LSP:

- LSP has partially activated its EOC and Critical Incident Management Staff (CIMS) beginning 9/10 at 0600 hours for 24-hour operations

DOC:

- Sandbagging in order to assist at-risk Parishes
- Incident Command center will be activated Wednesday (9/11) at 0700
- Transportation teams on standby
- Cameron Parish has evacuated 23 male inmates to Catahoula Parish
- Orleans Parish has evacuated 104 male and 43 female inmates to Louisiana State Penitentiary

LABEOC:

- The LABEOC is manned as of 0600
- Will host pre-storm coordination call at 1500 on 9/10
- Continue to work with private sector partners to ensure private sector is positioned to support response and recovery

LANG:

- Air coordination cell at GOHSEP is working with other Federal and State partners, including the US Coast Guard and LSP to synchronize Air Search and Rescue assets and operations

LDWF:

- Participating in a state Integrated Search and Rescue (ISAR) partners meeting this afternoon
- LDWF command staff is finalizing plans for deployment

Tangipahoa:

- Mass care - anticipate opening 3 shelters. Fire Marshall has been contacted. ARC has been requested
 - Restoration Church, 22494 US 190, Robert, LA 70455
 - Amite Community Center, 212 E Oak St, Amite, LA 70422
 - Browns Chapel, 70427 Martin Luther King Dr, Tangipahoa, LA 70465
- Self-service sandbags are available at all local Fire Departments
- Filled sandbags available starting tomorrow at 7am (Florida Parishes Arena and Pleasant Ridge Barn)
- 83 FEMA trailers are still occupied/Shelters will be available.
- Tangipahoa Parish will fully activate the EOC at 0600 on 9/11

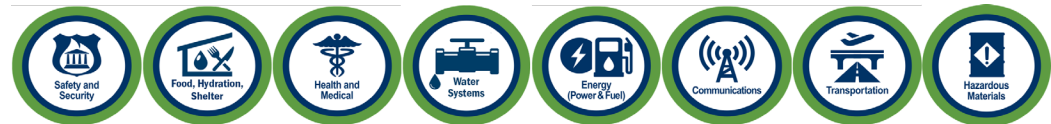

Jefferson:

- EOC is partially activated and will be operating 24 hours for the duration. Full level 1 activation is to occur 1800 on 9/10
- Mandatory evacuations for Grand Isle and Lafitte Residents outside of the levee flood protection to occur tomorrow.
- Nursing homes to shelter in place. Hospitals will be in storm activations and will handle as needed. Public Works (PW) departments will continue to empty storm drains as needed. PW departments have staged equipment as needed
- Terrytown Shelter to open at 1600 9/10. Shelter is for residents outside of the flood protection and living in camps, trailers, and mobile homes
- Shelter supplies distributed 9/9

Terrebonne:

- A mandatory evacuation of all areas located in Zone 1, which include all areas outside of the Morganza to the Gulf levee system is effective immediately. All residents must evacuate zone 1 by 0600 on Wednesday (9/11)
- Terrebonne Parish will open a shelter at the Houma Municipal Auditorium on Wednesday (9/11) at 0600
- The Terrebonne Parish Good Earth Transit will provide transportation to those who are need of transportation to the shelter

Assumption:

- Sand Bagging operations are currently available at the LSU Agriculture Center at 119 Robin St. in Napoleonville. Bags will be limited to 10 per vehicle. After 1700 you may need to bag the sand yourself, please bring a shovel.
- Sand and bags are also available at Veteran's Park in Pierre Part and Dorseyville Park in Belle Rose. Please bring your own shovel at these locations

- American Red Cross is preparing to open two Red Cross managed shelters and supporting parish shelters. Anticipate first shelter count tonight

LDAF:

- Made contact with all partners in preparing resources
- All coastal parish animal controls have been contacted and stand ready and prepared
- All animal shelters on standby upon activation
- Alexandria Pet Shelter on standby with 30 cages setup and ready for intake
