We THANK YOU, PSL Congregations, for your generous support! We thank each of you for your support and contribution, as we are one body with one purpose. With an optimistic heart, I send out the 2025 PSL Per Capita packet for your prayerful consideration.

The per capita pledge amount is based on membership data that is two years old. For instance, our 2025 pledge kits are based on the 2023 membership report, which includes 3,534 members. Through each of our members and congregations contributing, we are able to have strong and active Presbyterian mission across South Louisiana. I am pleased that we have more mission-based funds built into our general fund budget (youth ministry, campus ministry, disaster response, hunger and more), but to keep these missions/ministries going, we will need your help.

The PSL Finance Committee has carefully considered the mission and ministry of the Presbytery, and has proposed an <u>increase of the Total Per Capita rate to \$87.08 per member</u> (from \$80 per member for the past *six* years.) This increase will be voted on at the November PSL meeting, but is shared with you now to aid in your 2025 budget planning.

This increased Total Per Capita amount will include the following changes:

- GA Support: The rate of per capita asked by the GA has increased from \$9.80 to \$10.84. For the past three years, the Presbytery has absorbed the GA per capita increases, but this is no longer possible. Please remember PSL covers to the full GA per capita amount even when congregations do not give their full per capita.
- PSL Support: The PSL per capita amount will follow the GA increase of 11%. The PSL portion is increasing from \$65.40 to \$71.44.
- Synod Support: While the Synod does not ask for a specific per capita rate, they still depend on Presbytery funds to operate. The total for Synod support will remain constant at \$4.80.

I am looking forward to the year ahead for our Presbytery. One of the goals of my term as Treasurer is to see how we can best serve you. A decline in membership tells me that there may be a decline in the finances of your churches. I do not want pledging to be a burden to you or the members of your congregation. This is *our* Presbytery as we are one Body. If you cannot commit to the \$87.08 per member, please send what you can. All amounts are appreciated, and spent with oversight, judgement, and care. ## **Ways of Giving**

We appreciate each of our congregations and your contributions toward the work of the Presbytery. In the past year, we have introduced a new method of payment that should help our congregations and presbytery better handle our per capita payments.

• NEW to PSL: ACH Withdrawal or Bank Draft: Using our new portal (congregations can use bank drafts to make per capita and special offering payments. You can even set up recurring payments. This method of payment is easy to operate and schedule in advance. It also will cost considerably less than the processing fees for our credit card payment system. This is the best method for congregations to safely send in their payments to the presbytery.

- Credit Card Payments: PSL can still accept online credit card payments. This is available through the PSL website (www.pbysouthla.org) and through the link below. This method is best suited for individuals who wish to donate or pay for specific activities (ex.
